With the final reading of the Animal Control By-law, dog tags are required to be purchased from the Village Office.

A spayed or neutered animal is \$15.00

An intact male or female is \$30.00

Licenses are for the calendar year and due now.

Dogs are also required to be on a leash when off the owner's property.
