Fire 168 hectares. No expected spread overnight, will be confirmed via heli tour this morning.
 Completed brushing work around hydro poles.
 RAP crew working on South flank in the forest regeneration area to finish building a heli-pad. This will enable ground crews to set up a wet line on the South flank to protect hydro lines.
 SPU tentatively to disembark on Thursday.
 Fire flare-ups continue to be seen behind evacuated homes.
 Zeballos ballpark used extensively for helicopter staging area.

Current Objectives/Priorities: South flank: - Finish building a heli-pad on the south flank.
 North flank: - Monitor the evac route and the area behind homes under evacuation order for flare-ups and falling debris.
 Maintain safety of public and first responders.

Future Objectives/Priorities: - Continued focus on the area above homes under evacuation order and protection of the main powerlines to the community.
 - Extinguish fire in the forest regeneration area on the south flank.
 - Extinguish flare-ups behind homes on under evacuation order.
 - Seeking continual RCMP presence in the community while in State of Local Emergency.

Concerns/Problems: - Fire on the top of the ridge heading south toward the main powerlines to the community
 - Falling debris, trees and rocks
