## EVACUATION ORDER RESCIND

The Evacuation Order, pursuant to Section 12 (1) of the BC *Emergency Program Act*, effective May 1, 2019 at 12:00 am for the properties at 102, 104, 106 Maquinna Avenue; 206 Pandora Crescent; 402-B Ferris Road; 404 Ferris Road; and 406 Ferris Road has been **RESCINDED**, effective at 12:00 am on June 1, 2019.

As of 12:00 am on June 1, 2019, no Evacuation Alert or Order will remain in effect within the Village of Zeballos.

An Evacuation Order may need to be reissued; however, if that is deemed necessary the process will re-commence.

## COASTAL FIRE CENTRE BURN BAN

Effective as of noon on May 30th, **Category 2 Open Burns** are now prohibited in our region.



This prohibition applies to:

- Burning any material smaller than two metres high and three metres wide (other than campfires);
- Burning stubble or grass over an area less than 2,000 square metres;
- The use of fireworks, firecrackers, sky lanterns, burning barrels or burning cages the use of binary exploding targets (e.g., for rifle target practice).

*Campfires are still permitted.*

Until a campfire ban is in effect, please remember the following:

- Remove all leaves, and other flammable material from the area where you plan to light your campfire;
- Ensure a fire guard of rocks or a pit are used;
- Never have a campfire when it's windy; and,
- Keep a bucket of at least 8 liters of water close by the fire at all times.

Excerpt from the Zeballos Miner Newspaper from June 13, 1938-



**FIRST FIRE**

*Zeballos' first fire last Thursday morning did not amount to much but it brought home to residents the hazard of un-cleared lots.*

*It demonstrated, also, the impotence of the present fire fighting equipment while at the same time showed that it can be affective against a small blaze when caught in time.*

*The fire spread rapidly from a brush heap lying between the Pioneer Hotel and Dawson Bros. & Co. Before the volunteers and emergency hose arrived, the fire had spread to a large stump and was scorching some felled trees. Fortunately, the wind was not strong. The blaze was overcome after an hour's brisk work of the volunteers.*
