WATER CONSERVATION

It's July, and it's dry! Vancouver Island has been issued a Level 3 drought rating. In BC, drought ratings range from 1—4, with 4 being the driest. This calls for voluntary water conservation efforts!



Easy ways to conserve water during this time include:

- Limiting outdoor watering
- Reserving watering for mornings and evenings
- Planting drought-tolerant vegetation
- Taking shorter showers
- Turning off the tap while not in immediate use
- Installing water-efficient showerheads, taps and toilets

We appreciate any measure of water conservation.

SMALL BUSINESS SUPPORT

Any small businesses or not-for-profit organizations who may have been affected economically by the wildfire in Zeballos last summer can now apply for support through Red Cross.

Eligible small business owners and not-for-profit organizations meeting the minimum requirements may apply for up to \$20,000 in funding through the Red Cross' 2018 Support for Small Business Program. Business owners and non-profits can apply online until **September 30, 2019**.

The spring cleanup in May was successful! Many residents participated this year and it sure shows around the community. *Looking good!*



CATEGORY 2 FIRE VS. CAMPFIRE

Category 2 open fires are currently prohibited on Vancouver Island, however campfires are permitted.

What is the difference between Category 2 and a campfire?



CAMPFIRE:	CATEGORY 2 FIRE:
• Any fire smaller than 0.5 metres high by 0.5 metres wide	• 1 to 2 concurrently burning piles no larger than 2 metres high by 3 metres wide
• Learn more at www.gov.bc.ca	• Stubble or grass burning over an area less than 0.2 hectares
