Flushing certain items down the toilet causes problems for our municipal wastewater system, your personal septic systems, and the environment.



MEET THE UNFLUSHABLES

WIPES

Even if they say flushable, wipes don't break-down like toilet paper does!

PAPER TOWELS

Thick and absorbent are great in most cases, but not in our wastewater system!

HAIR

When hair is flushed it can bind other items together and create clogs.

DENTAL FLOSS

Floss is very similar to hair, but made of plastic! Floss can take years to decompose.

TAMPONS

They expand and absorb liquid and over time will clog pipes.

CONDOMS

Like hair, they can bind other objects together creating clogs.

Where to put unflushables?

Into the garbage



These products don't break down quickly enough in the wastewater system (or at all) and can end up clogging our sewers and your pipes.
