SHIFT INTO WINTER

Every day people face the risk of being injured or killed while driving. Driving in *winter* conditions can put you at even greater risk. If you must travel in the winter, work through these seven steps:

1. Check the current road conditions and weather forecast.
2. Plan your route ahead of time.
3. Leave lots of time so you're not rushing.
4. Learn winter road skills.
5. Keep at least four seconds distance between you and the vehicle in front of you.
6. Wear comfortable clothing that doesn't restrict your movement while driving.
7. Have an emergency plan.

HISTORY CORNER

Excerpt from the Zeballos Miner, June 29, 1940-

NEW RESERVOIR TO BE COMPLETED SOON

A sufficient reserve of water will soon be stored at the city waterworks. Owing to condition of the old dam, there has not been enough water storage to protect the town in case of fire during the dry season. Contractor A.W. Ford is building a reinforced concrete dam to retain ample water for a safe margin at all times. Work at the dam site is well under way and will be completed in a few days.

Excerpt from the Zeballos Miner, July 13, 1940-

HUGE RESERVOIR NOW COMPLETED

A.W. Ford & Co. have completed the new, large, concrete reservoir on the hill just beyond the town. It is now full of water to its capacity of 15,000 gallons. This is a valuable improvement of the water system. It is insurance against water shortage.
