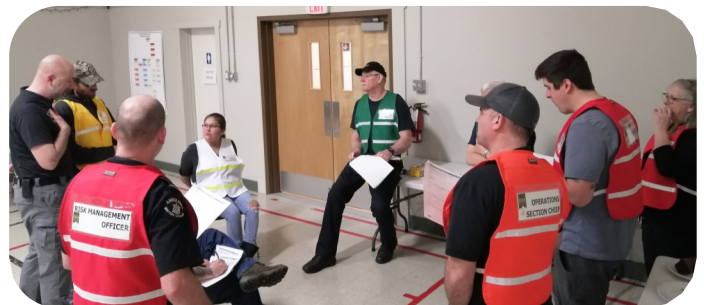
EMERGENCY OPERATIONS TRAINING

Over the past year, the Zeballos Emergency Program has been participating in training and table top exercises on how to run an Emergency Operation Centre in collaboration with Ehatis, Oclucje and Kyuquot. These training opportunities were able to happen through a UBCM Community Emergency Preparedness Fund grant that was awarded in 2019.



These four communities have received training on how to operate a portable Emergency Operation Centre Kit which will enable each community to support one another inside an Operation Centre during a local emergency. This creates resiliency; and as we all know, resiliency is important to have in communities of our capacity.

- by May 31**
- Property tax notices are mailed out
 - Utility bills are mailed out

Mid-June Contact us if you have not received your property tax notice or your utility bill

- July 2**
- Deadline to pay your property taxes
 - Deadline to apply for the home owner grant without late payment penalties
 - Deadline to pay your utility bill

- July 3**
- A 10% penalty is applied to unpaid property tax account balance, including any unclaimed home owner grants.
 - A 10% penalty is applied to unpaid utility bill account balance

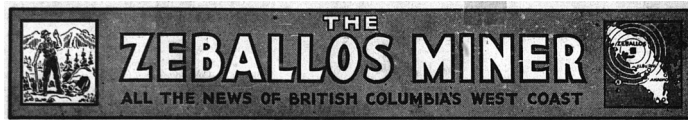

PIONEER HOTEL PREPARES FOR LICENSED PREMISES

On his return from Vancouver, Les Brown, proprietor of the Pioneer Hotel, announced that he would prepare the place immediately for licensed premises. Bar and fixtures will be installed and the premises finished and improved for the accommodation of the public in approximately two weeks.

The entire front of the hotel area is to be graveled. The Pioneer Hotel is the second license to be issued in Zeballos.
