UPCOMING PLANNED OUTAGES

BC Hydro has scheduled planned outages to perform end of life pole replacements and substation maintenance on the following dates:

Saturday, September 12th 11 am - 4 pm Sunday, September 13th 8 am - 6pm



Protect your equipment from damage during the outage by turning off all lights, electric heaters, major appliances and unplugging electronics.

Water Conservation During an Outage

Also, be reminded of the need to conserve water during a power outage. In Zeballos, water travels from the well to the reservoir via an electric powered pump system. If we can be conservative in our use, the pump will not have to start up as many times to keep our water supply constant.

Similarly, if you are on the sewer system, conserving your use of the sewer system will mean less time for the public works crew to manually pump down the system and avoid sewage overflow situations.

PARKING REMINDER



In a small town like Zeballos, parking can sometimes be tricky to find. Please park wisely, and ensure your vehicle is parked *completely* off of roadways to allow space for emergency response and other vehicle traffic to pass. Narrow streets, such as Reno St., do not always have the capacity for street parking.

It's also important to note, while "No Parking" signs may seem inconvenient, they serve an important public safety purpose and must be adhered to. *Thank you for keeping our community safe!*

2020 TAX SALE DEFERRAL

Recognizing the potential financial impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Province has enacted Ministerial Order M159, which enables municipal Councils to defer the 2020 Tax Sale. At the August 25th Regular Meeting, Village Council adopted a bylaw to defer the annual Tax Sale to **September 27, 2021.** Any taxes that are delinquent in 2020 will remain delinquent for 2021, with applicable interest charges.

The Frumento dry goods business has extended and now occupies the whole of the ground floor of the Frumento Block. The women's and children's department has been moved into the premises formerly occupied by the Zeballos Pharmacy. It is the largest dry goods store, men's, women's, children's wear, including boots and shoes, north of Port Alberni.
