Qualifications

A person is qualified to be nominated for, be elected to, and to hold office as Councillor if that person is:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day, January 18, 2025;
- A resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and
- Not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election in British Columbia or being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

Campaign Period Expense Limits

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, the following expense limits for candidates during the campaign period apply:

- Councillor \$5,398.95

Third-Party Advertising Limits

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2022 general local elections, the following third-party advertising limits apply:

- Third-party advertising limit \$809.84
